

WATER CONSERVATION NOTICE

Effective September 25, 2017, the Village of Arrowwood is asking residents to implement water conservation measures for all residents served by the Village of Arrowwood water supply.

The Village of Arrowwood will be performing a pump and recovery test on our Water Well #2. During this time, the water supply to the water plant will be shut down and water will have to be brought in by a trucking company. The pump testing is scheduled to take 3 days with a recovery of 1 to 2 days, meaning the Village will not be able to supply water from our wells for approximately 5 days. It's during this period that we are asking you, the residents, to conserve water as much as possible to ensure there will be enough drinking water available and to keep our costs down.

While water conservation is in place, all residents of the Village of Arrowwood are asked to eliminate nonessential uses of water, which include the following:

- The use of hoses, sprinklers, or other means for sprinkling or watering of shrubbery, trees, lawns, grass, plants, gardens, vegetables, flowers, etc.
- ➤ The use of water for washing automobiles, trucks, trailers, or any other type of mobile equipment.
- ➤ The washing of streets, driveways, parking lots, office buildings, exterior of homes, sidewalks, or other outdoor surfaces.
- ➤ The operation of an ornamental fountain or other structures making a similar use of water.
- Any other general water wastage.
